
UPDATE ON TRENT BOSCH'S SESSIONS

Trent's Saturday demo will include:one of his Vessels of Illusion with all of the processes that go into that including hollowing, carving, and wood bending. He will also be doing a bowl, talking about drying green wood, how to deal with that, as well as how to cut wood for best figure. And according to Trent, "a whole lot more".

Projects for the Sunday hands-on session will include a a bowl, hollow forms, and some carving on some of them. Trent says, "Whatever each individual wants to pursue. It is really helpful if the people in the hands on class attend the demo - that way we can hit the ground running and they can get more hands on time."
